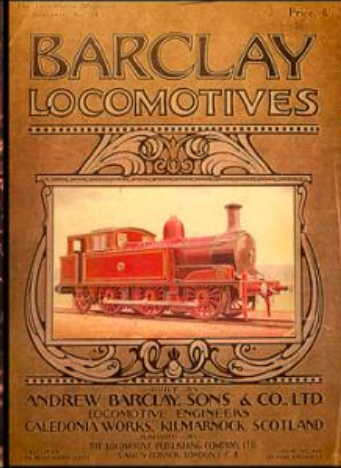


Paul Barclay
